A Community of Action (CoA) brings like-minded Digital Health Canada Members together to produce a deliverable on any health informatics (HI) or digital health topic in which they share an interest. Operating as a team with a Leader, Coordinator, and Contributors, CoA participants exchange ideas and information, enhance their understanding of a particular HI subject, and seek answers to specific questions.


Work with digital health professionals from across the country.

The great thing about the CoA community is that it connects people of different levels, from different cities, across multiple sectors—all working toward a common goal. Leading a CoA is a great way to get a fresh perspective on a project or a creative solution to a challenge. Joining a CoA will introduce you to new colleagues, expand your career horizons, and add a publication to your resume.

All you need to get started is a great idea.

1. To begin, simply fill out the application online. Define your CoA mission, outline what the deliverable will be, and set a schedule.
2. Organize the CoA structure: who will Lead, Coordinate and Contribute. Digital Health Canada will help gather a small, functional volunteer team with the right mix of skills and capabilities.
3. Connect, discuss, share ideas, and learn from your CoA group members as you work toward completion of your deliverable. The Team Coordinator will facilitate group collaboration and keep things on track, and the Digital Health Canada Coordinator will check in with regularly to make sure everyone is on schedule.
4. Complete your deliverable. The Digital Health Canada Coordinator will help with layout, publication, and promotion as you share your success with your fellow Digital Health Canada Members.


