

Retaining your CPHIMS-CA certification

There are two ways to renew your certification:

1. Obtain a total of 60 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) and pay the renewal fee by your expiration date.
- OR -
2. Re-write and successfully pass the certification exams.

Where to earn CEUs

If you choose renewal option one, you must earn the required 60 CEUs by participating in professional education activities in the following categories:

- A minimum of 25 CEUs must be obtained from HIMSS or HIMSS Approved Provider activities ;
- A minimum of 10 CEUs must be obtained from Digital Health Canada activities;

Remaining CEUs can be obtained from other providers of HI professional education activities. If you are unsure if a particular event/activity qualifies for CEUs, please send the agenda to education@digitalhealthcanada for confirmation.

How to keep track of CEUs

Log in to your HIMSS account at www.himss.org to track your CEU credits (you are responsible for tracking your own CEUs as you earn them).

When to renew

You may renew and pay for your recertification online as early as six months prior to, but no later than, the expiration date on your certificate.
