Background and Overview of Priorities

OOHC Overview



- The Ontario Oracle Health collaborative (OOHC) reconvened in 2021 to support hospitals to more closely align in their digital health implementations and operations.
- The OOHC includes representation from all hospitals using or implementing Oracle Health in Ontario, which covers 11 instances across 63 hospital sites.
- The collaborative has monthly meetings to review project updates and discuss items of interest. The first in-person retreat was held in June 2023 to discuss priorities, challenges, and opportunities for the members.

Collaborative Priorities



<u>Priority 1:</u> Drive consistent and standardized implementation of Digital Health initiatives through the planning, direction, and oversight of current and future projects.



Ocean to Cerner integration

- Integrate the Ocean eReferral platform to Oracle Health to automate referral and optimize appointment scheduling and notification processes
- Currently focused on Diagnostic Imaging pathway
- Goal to implement the Ocean Integration with 11 sites



Ontario eHub integration

- Bi-directional Health Information Exchange (HIE) between Oracle and Long Term Care Homes, as well as Health Information System (HIS) to HIS data exchange with other hospitals
- 38 hospitals are currently contributing patient data to the Ontario eHub
- 25 Oracle Hospitals (43 sites) live; 263 Long Term Care Homes Live



Cross-Collaborative Project

- Purpose is to support Mental Health and Addictions (MHA) patient journey between hospitals through integrating HIS in Ontario.
- Implementing at these sites by the end of fiscal: University Health Network, Centre for Addiction and Mental Health, and Royal Ottawa Mental Health Centre

Collaborative Current Priorities



Priority 2: Provide a forum to share relevant leading practices from Digital Health implementations.



- Developing and sharing key best practices related to adoption and utilization of Digital Health tools
- Creating readily accessible communication channels amongst the collab for information sharing and support, such as a shared team site and chat/forum

Priority 3: Collectively engage with the province and the vendor, Oracle Health, on digital health opportunities and challenges.
