

Faster access to care



Hiring more health care workers


Recruiting, retaining, and optimizing to ensure we have the right number, type and distribution of health care professionals.

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



Ontario Health Provincial Digital Blueprint




Building or Expanding Provincial Services



Unified Patient Access Experience

- User Arrives at Health811 and Wants Access
- User Creates a Credential
- Users will be presented with options to login, including:
 - Creating a My Ontario Account (MOA) (Public Secure)
 - Leveraging banking credentials e.g. Interac Sign-In



- User Completes
 Online Identity
 Verification
- User undergoes document, biometric and data verification
- Government issued document e.g. Health card is analyzed for fraud to match facial biometrics to photo ID to ensure the Health card is presented by rightful owner
- Health card data is verified against the source.




- 4 Account Created
- Once verified, users will be able to access eligible digital health services with a single Login ID and password
- Health card and identity data is stored centrally and shared with health services with user consent



Moving to a More Coordinated and Integrated Approach


SILOED

Organizations are operating independently, leaving clinicians with a sense of confusion about who to contact when adopting and using solutions, increasing




COORDINATED



Provincial Central Intake Model






