▶ Health Infostructure Atlantic & Tele i-4:

- ▶Partnership between Atlantic provinces and Health Canada.
- ▶Integrated digital image transmission (PACS) across the four provinces.
- ▶Canadian e-health submission for UN World Summit Award

► ACCESS Atlantic:

- ▶Partnership between four Atlantic provinces and Infoway
- ► Multi-faceted program to accelerate patient access to health care through digital technologies
- ▶Enabled rapid deployment of virtual care in response to COVID pandemic

► Atlantic Physician Registry:


- ▶ Council of Atlantic Premiers initiative
- Removes interprovincial barriers to practicing medicine in the region, allowing Atlantic physicians to practice in any Atlantic province.
- ▶ Golden Scissors Award from CFIB

- The Atlantic Digital Health Collaborative is a strategic initiative currently being explored with the four Atlantic Health Ministries.
