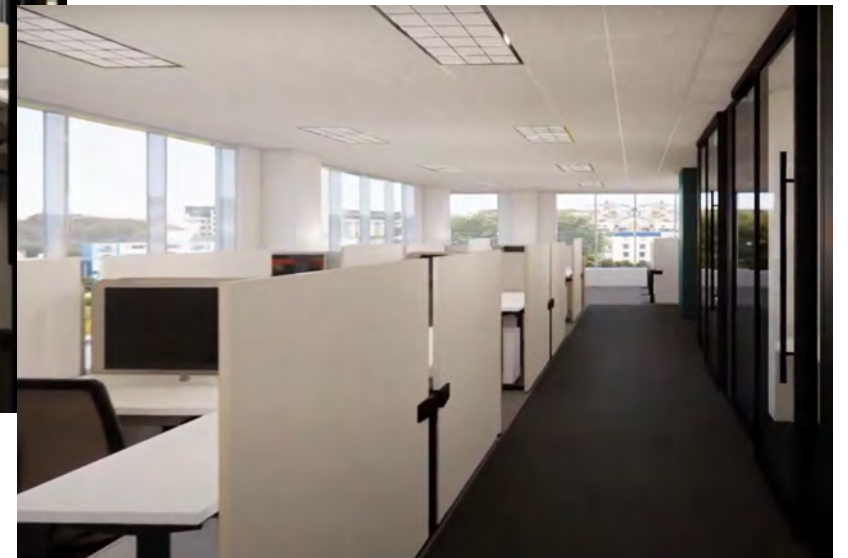
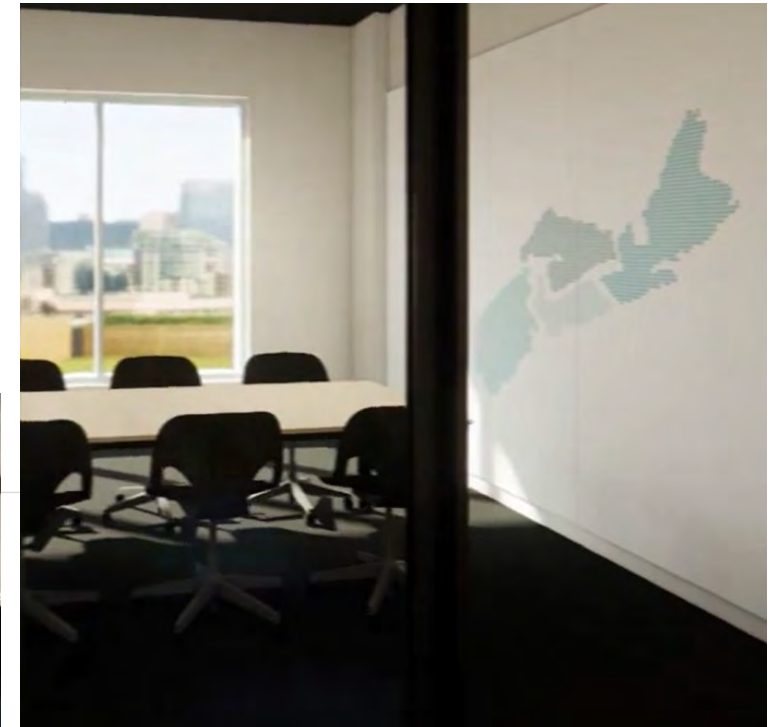
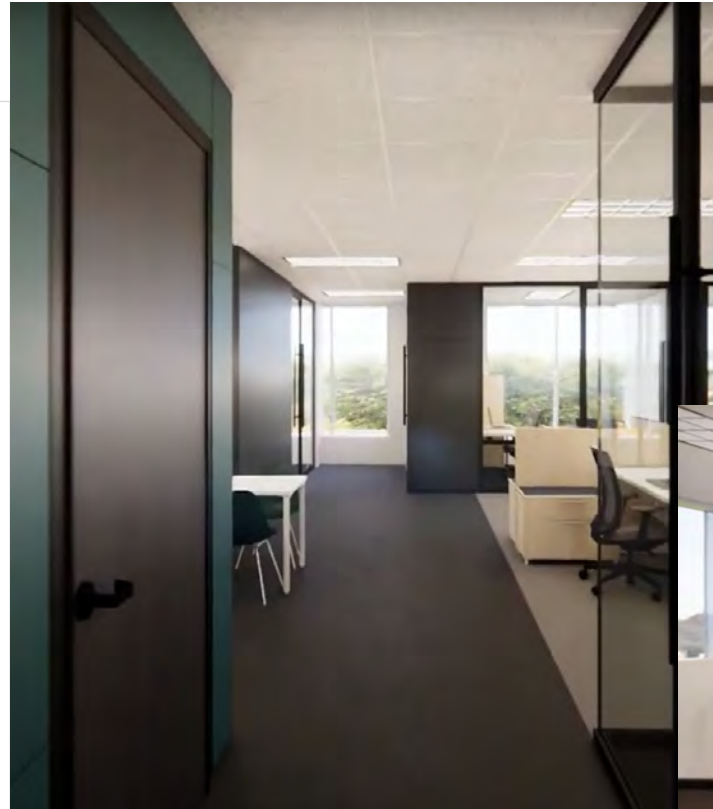
3rd Floor

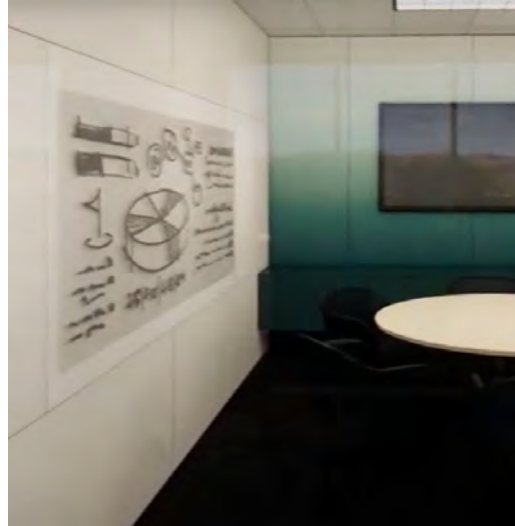




Meeting Rooms

The NEW Provincial C3



The centrepiece of the Performance Centre is the creation of the new provincial Care Coordination Centre (C3) on the 5th floor. The Care Coordination Centre, also known as C3, is a collaborative approach to decision-making using real-time data that will improve how we coordinate the movement of patients throughout the healthcare journey using GE's command centre software. It provides a real-time view on access to care, patient flow and health system resources to support teams to identify issues and communicate solutions together.



C3 was rolled out in phases. We started at the Halifax Infirmary site of the QEII Health Sciences Centre with the Central Zone C3. There will be zone C3s that will feed into the provincial C3.
